

AUDITING CLASSES

Visiting Law Students

(This policy is not applicable to current McGeorge School of Law students)

Any current law student attending an ABA law school who wishes to audit a class at Pacific McGeorge School of Law must be admitted to McGeorge School of Law. The Office of Admissions will notify the visiting student as to whether he/she will be allowed to audit.
