For Clinics which require an application, you must put yourself on the waiting list during on-line registration and also complete the application process. **You should go ahead and register for a full load, pending results of the clinical application process.**

You will be contacted as to whether or not you are accepted for a Clinic. An interview (in person or by telephone) may be conducted by the supervising attorney.

You may only participate in one Clinic at a time due to the time commitment for Clinic responsibilities.

For those Clinics which do **not** require an application, you may only register for one Clinic.

For those Clinics requiring an application, you may submit a separate application for more than one Clinic, but you will only be enrolled in one Clinic — so **be sure** to indicate your first choice. You may also register for one Clinic that does not require an application. If you are accepted for a Clinic requiring an application, you will be dropped from the other Clinic.
