Students are required to take Legal Process LL.M. and at least one of the following foundational law courses: Civil Procedure (3 or 5 units), Contracts (3 or 5 units), Property (3 or 5 units), Torts (3 or 5 units), Criminal Law (3 units), Constitutional Law I (2 units), or Constitutional Law II (3 units). The section is to be determined in consultation with the advisor. In addition, a candidate may choose to focus on a specific substantive area, for example, Business Law, Criminal Justice, Environmental Law, Intellectual Property Law, or Tax, by selecting relevant elective courses or engaging in Directed Research in the particular area.
