After the interview, your resume will be sent to the placements selected, and you will be contacted by some of those placements to set up a personal interview. When an externship offer has been made and you have accepted, return to the Field Placement Office to complete a Course Enrollment form to be approved by the Field Placement Director, Colleen Truden.
