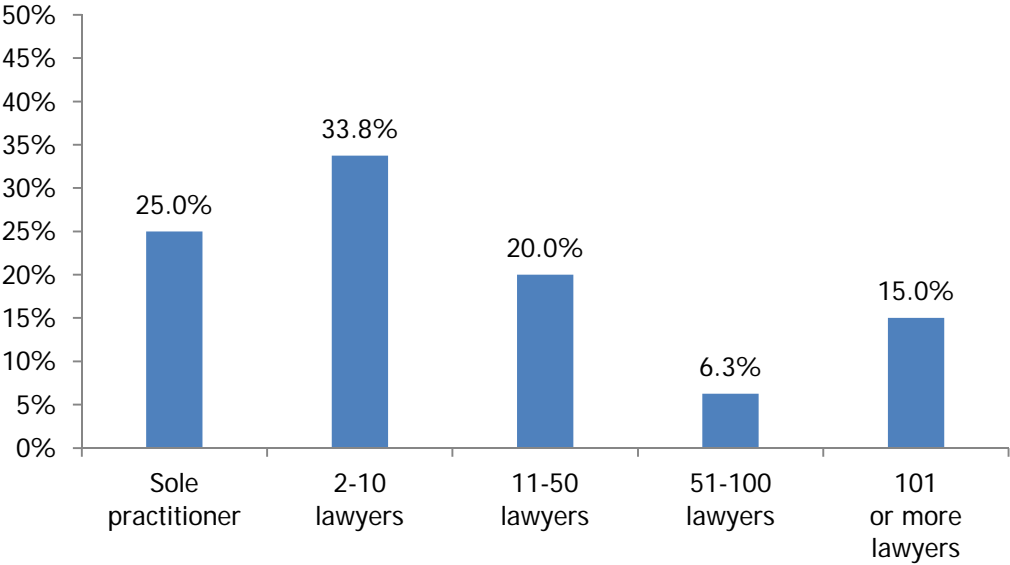
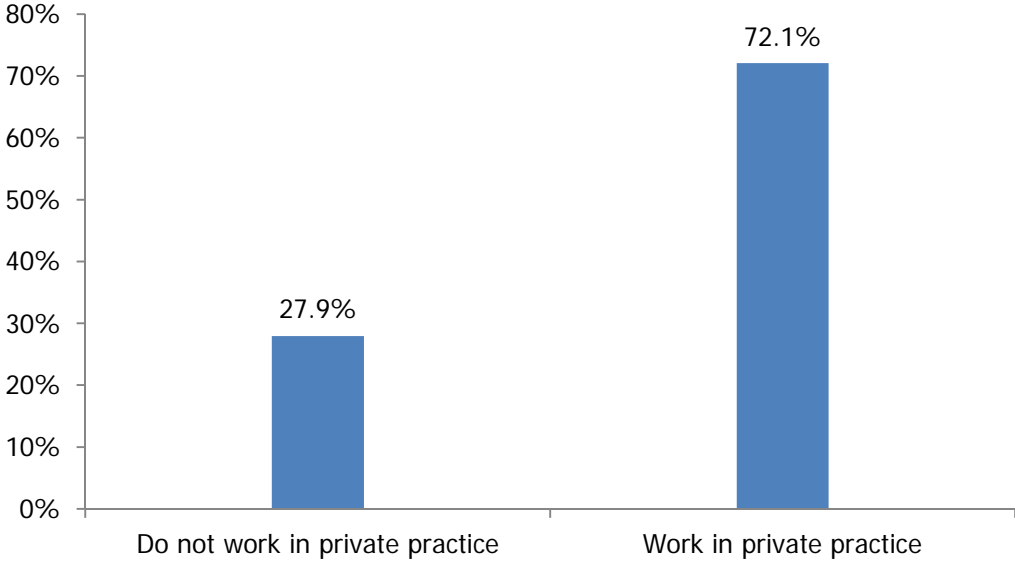
1. If you are (or have) engaged in the practice of law, please indicate which best describes how you would characterize your practice



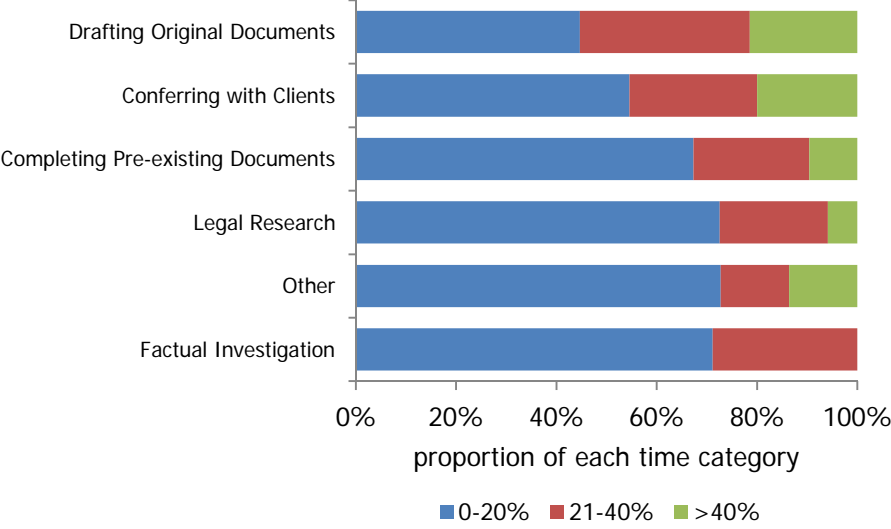
2. Please indicate the percentage of your time spent on each of the activities



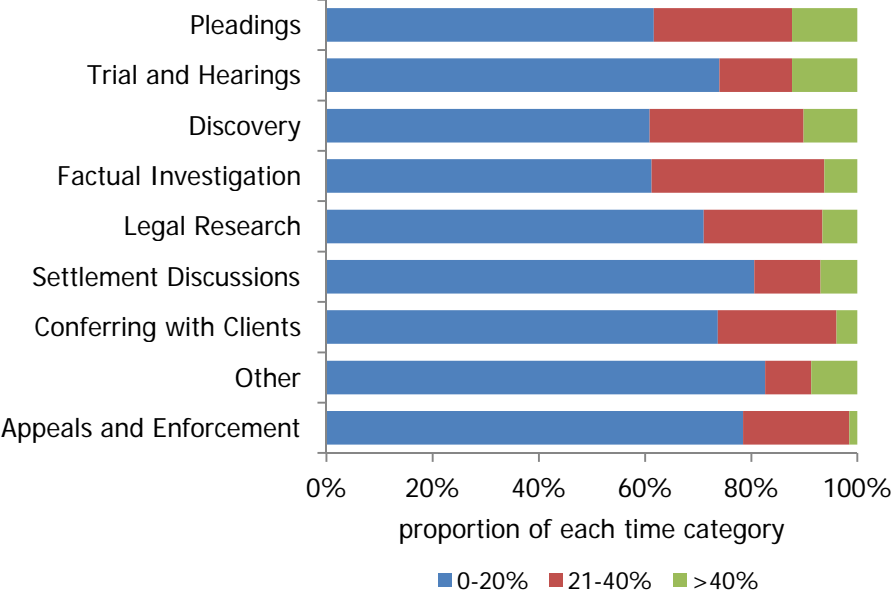
3. If you are/were in private practice working in a law firm, which best describes the size of your firm?



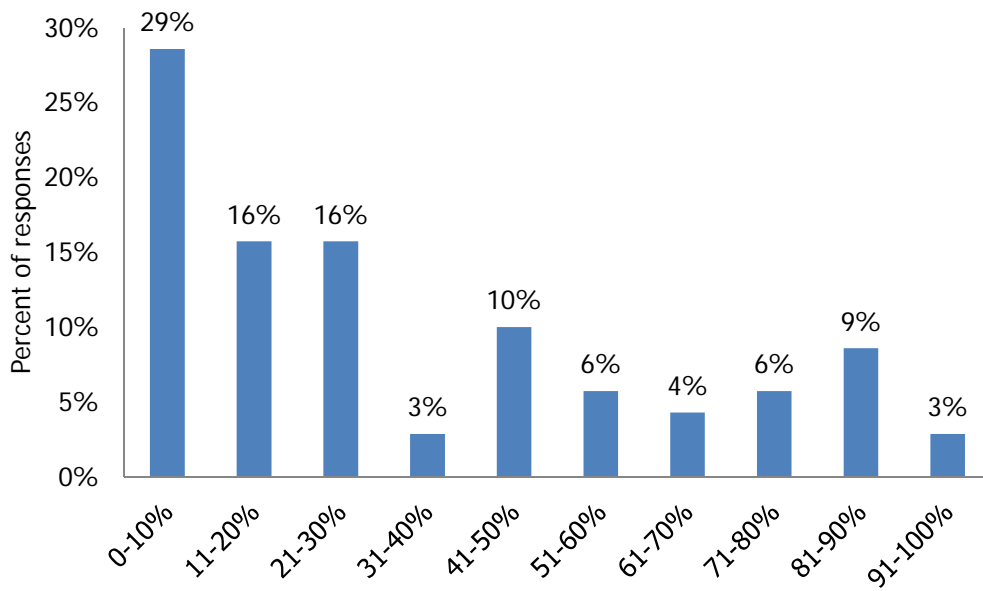
4. If you engage(d) in transactional work, please indicate the percentage of your time spent on each of these activities



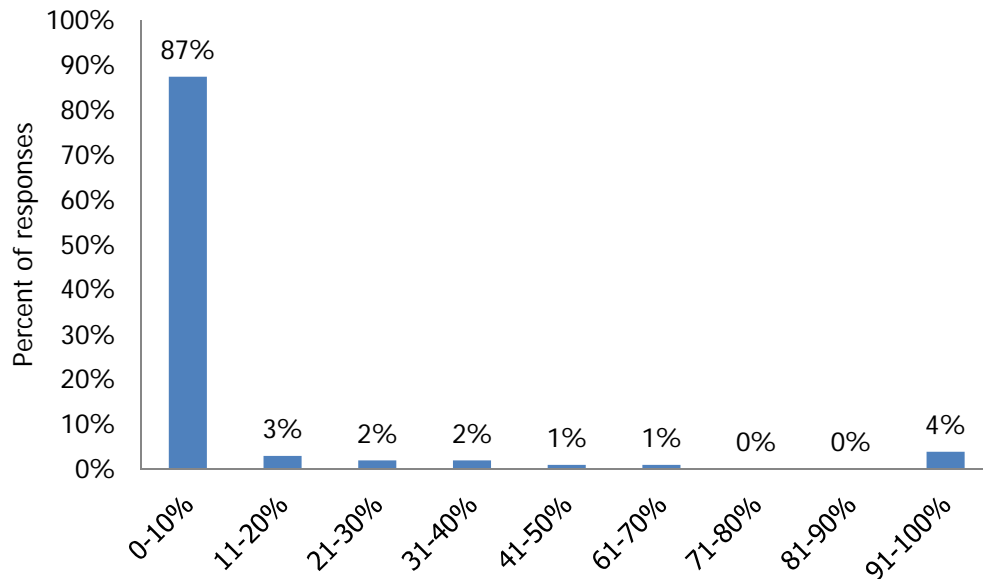

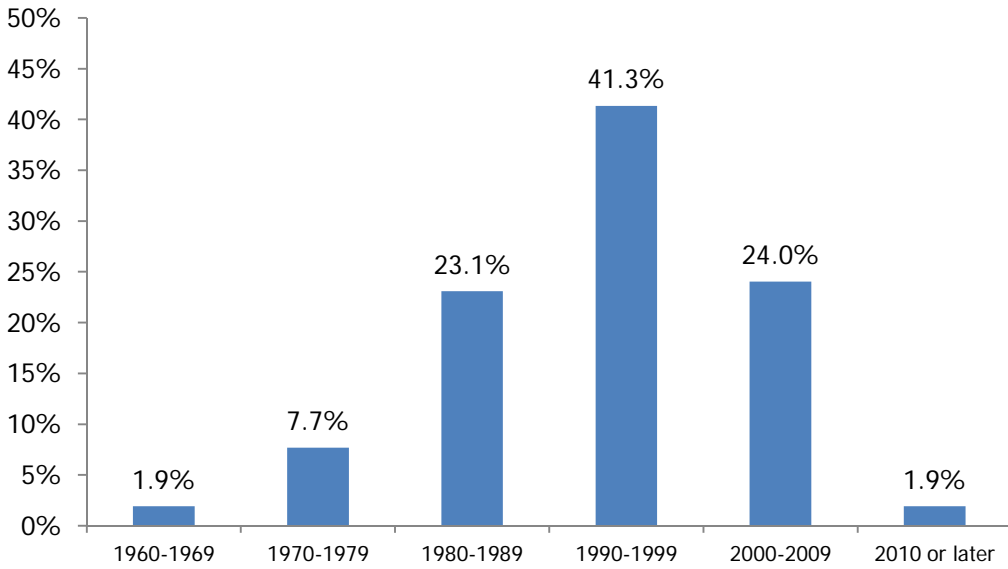

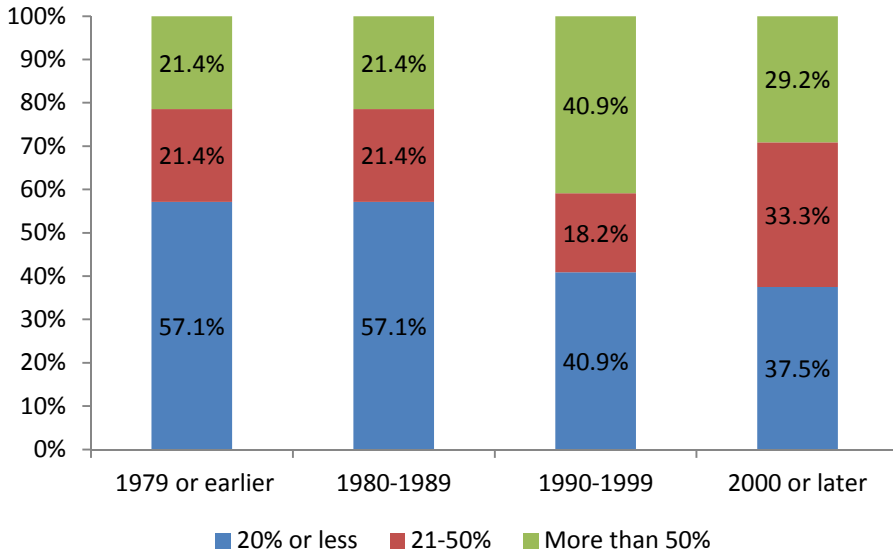
