Essential Duties and Accountabilities (in order of importance):

3. Cleans hoods and walls.
4. Empties trash.
5. Assists with all aspects of catering events, including but not limited to set up, clean up, delivery, and food preparation.
6. Assists with prep work and deli services.
7. Performs other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Six months experience as a dishwasher preferred.
- Knowledge of current Health and Safety regulations.
- Proper use and maintenance of standard restaurant equipment.
- Communicate well with customers, subordinates, and upper management.
